The Mustangs finally broke Blake's three-year stranglehold on Section 2A to earn their first bid since winning the whole thing in 2004. Breck was extremely young last year, loaded with sophomores who have developed nicely as juniors this winter.

Juniors Tyson Fulton, Mike Morin and Riley Borer all scored more than 20 goals and give Breck great scoring balance up and down the lineup.

But the key contributors remain the only two seniors on the roster: Joe Rehkamp (21-40-61) on the forward lines and defenseman Reid Herd. They are the glue that hold the Mustangs together.

Breck racked up a huge season against a downtrodden Tri-Metro Conference. In 14 conference games, the Mustangs outscored their opposition by a huge 107-10 margin and had six shutouts. The Mustangs won 19 of their last 20 games (the other was a tie with Totino-Grace) and haven't

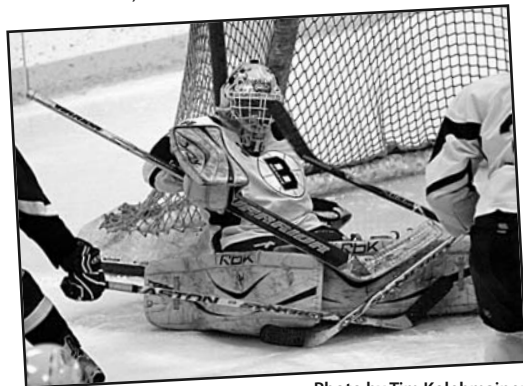

lost since a 5-4 overtime setback to Wayzata in the Schwan Cup Silver semifinals on Dec. 30.

Goalies John Russell and Max McCormick have combined for eight shutouts, although Russell is expected to get the

majority of time in nets. He's a big wall of pads in the crease and is very good at smothering rebounds.

The Mustangs picked up the fourth and final seed by the coaches, setting up a quarterfinal matchup with Rochester Lourdes late Wednesday night. The two teams know each other well, as Breck earned a 5-3 victory back on Jan. 17. Breck overcame a 3-2 second-period deficit with three unanswered goals, two from Borer. The Eagles outshot the Mustangs, but Russell came up big with 28 saves. Rehkamp had a goal and three assists. ■
